
HALEY: Heart transplant patient Haley is heading home to Ewing, VA after spending over 110 days at Fox Hollow. We are so happy that she has been cleared by doctors to continue her recovery at home with her community of friends and family, but we will miss the light her smile brought to the room. Haley was able to utilize the exercise bike at the gym at Stone Creek Village to expedite and aid her rehabilitation. Wishing her continued healing and a full recovery.

Mom left us this note: "Our daughter Haley had to have a heart transplant. One of our worries was where we were going to stay for several months. We live in Southwest VA, 6 hrs away from Charlottesville and UVA Hospital. To be told that there is a foundation that provides a free long-term stay during our devastating time, what a heartwarming gift. The Yellow Door Foundation provided us comforts of home away from home, and gave us one less stress to worry about. Yellow Door has been a blessing to our family to be able to be together during Haley's heart transplant journey. The love and support. MARGIE: Margie finally received a new heart in May. When the heart failed, she was quickly moved to the top of the transplant list and luckily another match became available within two weeks. She underwent her second transplant surgery early June. Margie's social worker said Margie was one of the most joyful patients with whom she has worked. We are hopeful Margie will make a full recovery. The family is staying at the VOGA Apartment.



MAYA: Maya received her new heart in March and recovery has been slow but steady. Victoria (mom) and Maya have been calling Baer-Hart House home for the past three months and are hopeful to return to Richmond in late June. Fortunately the weather is getting warmer so Maya can use the pool to regain some strength in her legs. Maya has been in a wheelchair since her operation. The gym and pool are just other reasons why the amenities at SCV help improve outcomes for YDF patients. Like Haley, she has been visiting the Stone Creek Village gym to work on full body strength as well. All her hard work is paying off. HELENA: Helena's CAR T cell treatment was a success and she is in remission! CAR T is when a patient's immune cells are used to treat their cancer. Helena



will still require a stem cell transfer as part of her treatment for leukemia. She will head to Cincinnati for this procedure in July and then return to UVA Children's to complete her treatment protocol. We are thrilled that this initial step to curing Helena was successful and she is on the path to recovery.



CHLOE: Chloe continues her treatment for stage 4 kidney cancer. She had challenges with infections but is much better now. Recently she assisted with our purse raffle drawing. Check her out the video below.



AVI: As reported last month when we introduced the YDF community to Avi's family, Avi received his donor heart. He has been released to join his family at Rosie's Place where he will continue recovering 3-4 weeks before heading home.



RAYMOND:

Raymond's family was the first to call Tommy's Place "home." In early June he experienced complications which required him to be flown to Cincinnati. He is stable now and awaiting a second stem cell transfer.
