These funds will play a crucial role in furnishing apartments #8 and #9 and are specifically dedicated to outfitting apartments that meet the stringent standards required for our immunocompromised patients, including repainting with MRSA-resistant paint, replacing carpet with engineered hardwood, and incorporating ADA accommodations in our bathrooms.

Atticus**

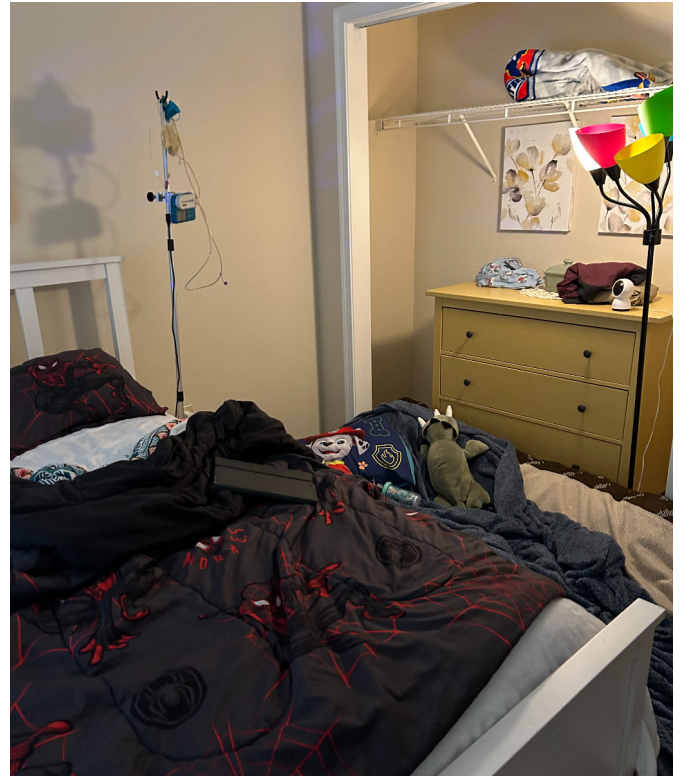


Three-year-old Atticus, his one-year-old brother Zaxton and their parents, became our 91st family when they moved into the VOGA apartment earlier this month.
