Hazen: We welcomed six-year-old Hazen and his mom, Stacy, to The Welcoming Nest this past month. Hazen is in his favorite spot nestled on the cozy couch. He loves his new Nintendo Switch, which was gifted to him by previous Nest resident, Helena.

Hazen has Rhabdomyosarcoma, which is a rare type of cancer that forms in soft tissue. He is in his 10th week of treatments. Mom shares, "Hazen has a large mass in his stomach near his organs and it's wrapped around a couple major blood vessels."

Hazen's five siblings will be joining him and mom at The Nest for the holidays.



AUBREE: The Baer-Hart House opened its doors to three-year-old Aubree and her family in early December. **Aubree received her new heart 363 days after her dilated cardiomyopathy diagnosis.**

Mom says, "It has been a rough year for the whole family with multiple ICU stays, differing answers and outlooks and a baby who didn't have the stamina like she used to. Since receiving her new heart she has been thriving and healing better than anyone could expect. She is learning new words everyday, gaining more and more stamina and eating so much food her parents run to the store every other day! As her body continues to acclimate to its new norm and stave off rejection, there is nothing but great things in this little one's future."

We are so happy Aubree is doing well. She will continue recovery through the holidays with Yellow Door.

Mom shared, "Yellow Door has been a soft landing place for us as we find a new normal so far from home. The apartment has been such a great place for Aubree to heal and get back to her sassy self. Having all the comforts of home, we are settling in nicely and enjoying watching her run around and play with her toys. We cannot put into words how grateful we are for this organization and its generosity of members and donor's."

HELENA: After a 310 day stay at our Nest apartment, during which time she underwent a successful stem cell transplant, Helena and dad Rob headed to Florida!

Helena is currently cancer free and continues recovery with sun, sand and sea as her companions.



CHLOE: Chloe and her parents have been calling The Dreamer Apartment "home" since April. This is Chloe completing chemo cycle 11 of 14. She has done fantastic so far! Chloe has endured some side effects that have altered her treatment schedule. However, mom shares on social media that there have been very minimal side effects this time for which they are so thankful.

Recently, the nurses brought her a badge and asked Chloe to join their team. She was more than a little bit thrilled! **She's now an honorary RN!**


